

INSTRUCTIONS FOR AUTHORS

Submission of Manuscripts. Please submit your original manuscript, along with three copies and electronic files to Dirk Guldí, Editor – *Fullerenes, Nanotubes, and Carbon Nanostructures*, Friedrich-Alexander-Universität Erlangen-Nürnberg, Institute for Physical Chemistry, Egerlandstr. 3, D-91058 Erlangen, Germany. E-mail: dirk.guldi@chemie.uni-erlangen.de. One copy must be the original “top” copy: the others may be good quality photocopies. Each paper judged by *Fullerenes, Nanotubes, and Carbon Nanostructures* editors to have potential for publication in the journal will be peer-reviewed. Manuscripts will be accepted with the understanding that their content is unpublished and is not being submitted for publication elsewhere. Authors are responsible for obtaining permission to reproduce copyrighted material from other sources and are required to sign an agreement for the transfer of copyright to the publisher.

All materials must be typed (12-point font) and double-spaced on 8.5 x 11 inch white paper with 1¼-inch margins. Number manuscript pages consecutively throughout the paper. Authors should also supply a shortened version of the title suitable for the running head, not exceeding 35 character spaces. Each article should be summarized in an abstract of no more than 100-150 words. Authors must give approximately five key words that identify the most important subjects covered by the paper.

Notes and References. Include only references to books, articles and bulletins actually cited in the text. References in the text should cite the author’s last name, year of publication, and page (where appropriate).

References in the reference list should follow Chicago Manual of Style.

Spelling and Hyphenation. The authority is *Webster’s Unabridged Dictionary*.

Affiliation. On the title page, include full name of the authors, academic or professional affiliations, a brief running head, and the complete address (**email address must be included**) of the person to whom proofs and correspondence should be sent.

Tables. Tables should be clearly typed with double spacing. Number tables with consecutive Arabic numerals and give a clear descriptive heading. Avoid the use of vertical rules in tables. Table footnotes should be typed below the table, designated by superior lower-case letters. A list of captions should be typed on a separate sheet and included with the typescript.

Illustration. Figures submitted (line drawings, halftones, photos, photomicrographs, etc.) should be clean originals or digital files. Digital files are recommended for highest quality reproduction and should follow these guidelines:

- 300 dpi or higher
- sized to fit on journal page
- EPS, TIFF, or PSD format only
- submitted as separate files, not embedded in text files

Color illustrations will be considered for publication; however, the author will be required to bear the full cost involved in their printing and publication. The charge for the first page with color is \$900.00. The next three pages with color are \$450.00 each. A custom quote will be provided for color art totaling more than 4 journal pages. Good-quality color prints or files should be provided in their final size. The publisher has the right to refuse publication of color prints deemed unacceptable.

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
